**Subject :- Amendment in the Recruitment Rules of MO-III, MO-II and MO-I of IMD – Regarding.**

It has been noticed in the Recruitment Rules of MO-III that all the MTS, whether Matriculate or Non-Matriculate, are eligible for promotion to the post of MO-III after regular service of six years and as per the Recruitment Rules of MO-II, all the MO-III, who have completed their modular training, are eligible for promotion to the post of MO-II after five years of regular service.

2. As per details available on the website of Meteorological Training Institute IMD Pune, MA (now MTS) with matriculation with five years' service and LA (now MO) are eligible for Modular Training Course.

In this regard, I would like to draw your attention to the fact that if any MO-III does not undergo modular training, he will not be eligible for promotion to the post of MO-II, but in such a case he will also block the prospects of promotion of his feeder cadre, i.e., MTS, till his retirement. This is the present scenario in the MO-III cadre wherein a large number of the personnel of this cadre are not willing to undergo the said training and thus blocking the promotion prospects of the MTS cadre.


4. To overcome this situation, it is requested that Modular training may be incorporated in the RRs of MO-III in place of RRs of MO-II so that only willing and eligible MTS get the chance of promotion to the MO cadre. Further, it is requested that the necessary qualification of Matriculation may also be withdrawn from the eligibility of Modular training so that only the interested candidates in the cadre of MTS may apply for the said training. In view of the above, it is requested that the Recruitment Rules of MO-III and MO-II may be amended suitably as this will aid in the promotion prospects of the currently stagnating MTS cadre.
