I would like to draw your kind attention to the annual NGSU meeting held on 23.09.2016 and in continuation of that I would like to submit few points for your consideration.

Inclusion of Compensatory off in the service records :

Due to non-recruitment, retirement on superannuation and other Government Policies there is an enormous vacancy in all the feeder posts of IMD and thus there is acute shortage of staff in IMD. Most of the units are working with only 40-50% staff strength. Continuous operational duties cannot be managed by sanctioned staff as staffs are going on leave (CL, EL, HPL), tours, trainings etc. along with regular public holidays so the vacancies created by staffs are managed by giving compensatory offs.

The staff is accumulating compensatory off to an amount of 1000 hours. These need to be realized or the staff should be permitted to avail. Hence it was requested that a permanent solution should be formulated and implemented.


