We also request that to benefit the existing senior officers the promotion list may be released after consideration of the combined service.

With reference to our earlier letters and the reply received from the UPSC, it is clear that the combined service can be considered for filling of SO-I posts that were created due to cadre restructuring by surrendering the lower posts.

Hence this union once again humbly requests you to kindly reconsider the stagnation and the combined service criteria so that all the posts thus created by the virtue of restructuring can be filled and the promotional benefit is extended to the maximum possible extant.
