Sub: Implementation of R.R. Mali Committee Report-regarding

I would like to draw your kind attention to the informal meeting with our Chairman, Shri Pramod G. Sawant during your recent visit to Mumbai. You were kind enough to express your deep concern and assured that you will personally look into the matter and do the needful.

I am writing this letter to raise one of the issues related to R.R. Mali Committee Report.

A committee was constituted by the competent authority vide office order No. A-32030/1/12-E-III dated 19.08.2014 under the chairmanship of Shri R.R.Mali, DDGM (SI) Pune to examine and review the requirements of Technical Group-C manpower for different purposes, their skill enhancement and career progression.

Mali Committee has divided the Group-C Technical cadre mainly into following five groups:

i)	MTS	1447
ii)	Meteorological Observer (I, II & III)	212
iii)	Driver	56
iv)	Mechanical (Non-Industrial)	186
v)	Mechanical (Industrial)	434

As per Mali Committee report the total Sanctioned Strength of Group-C Technical cadre was 2335 as on 01-06-2015.

Mali Committee has submitted its report on 04.11.2015. The approval of administrative ministry, Integrated Finance division, DOPT and MOF is needed to implement the recommendations of Mali Committee report. More than one year has been over and Mali report is still pending with MoES/IMD. Now it is observed that IMD Workshop Union has

requested to implement the MOF GSR No. 552(E) dated 28.07.2009 meant for workshop staff which will again delay the implementation of Mali Committee report.

In view of this, it is requested that part related to Mechanical (Industrial) cadre of Mali Committee report may be removed for the time being and may be take up separately so that the remaining 80% staff could get the benefit of Mali Committee report.

This union accepts the recommendation of Mali Committee report and requested that the Mali Committee report may be implemented as early as possible.
